This week we will be looking at the digraphs 'ar', 'or', 'ur', and 'ow'.

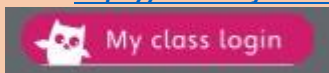
Practice the phonics sounds set on Purple Mash.

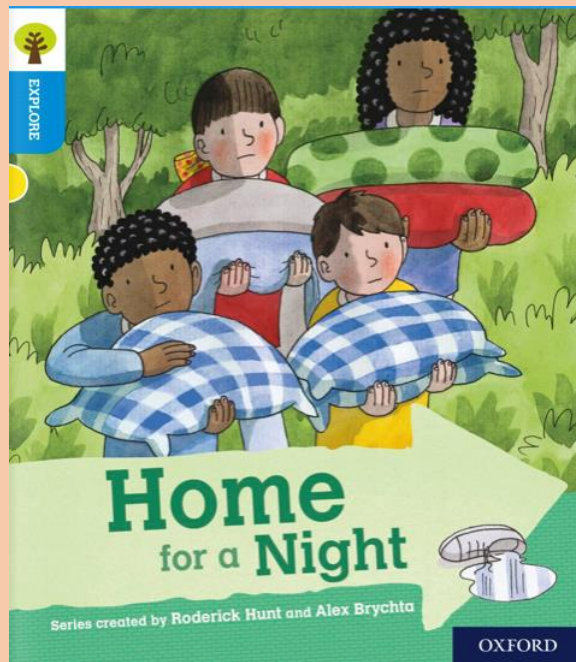

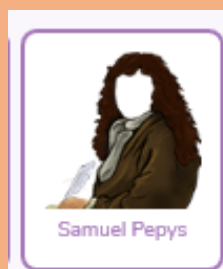

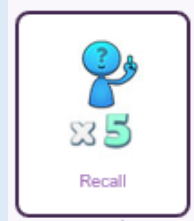
