This Week's Assembly Focus: Money
This week in assembly, we explored the theme of Money, linking it to two key

<u>Individual Liberty – We all have the</u> freedom to choose how we spend our money.

<u>Mutual Respect –</u> We must always respect the choices others make about how they manage their money.

The children reflected on how they use their own money. They thought about whether they spend it on things they need—like food or clothes—or on things they simply want.

We discussed an important question: Can we always afford what we want? As we learn more about money, we reminded ourselves to always be respectful of others, regardless of their age or ability, and to be kind and fair in how we share or spend it.
