<u>In Literacy</u>



This term the children will be reading lots of exciting Stories. We will be using puppets and masks, and learning all about different stories through different activities set around the classroom. We will be encouraging ALL children to begin to write their name using a name card.

<u>How you can help at home....</u>

*Read to your child EVERY DAY, make sure they hear different stories and enjoy favourite ones regularly so they can re-tell them on their own.

*Make sure they do their homework in their drawing book. *Write their name for them to begin to copy. Remember capital letter only for the first letter and then all the rest lower case.



<u>In Maths</u>

The children count everyday to check how many children are in Pre-School. We sing lots of number songs such as,

1,2,3,4,5, 5 Little Speckled Frogs, 5

little monkeys.

We will be using different words to describe the size of objects such as big and little. We will also be organising and categorising objects.

<u>How you can help at home...</u>

*Sing some different number songs at home or in the car and encourage your child to join in doing the actions and singing along.
