

The children will be reading different story books, describing the characters, setting and retelling the story. Encourage children to use adjectives when talking and ask them to identify the describing word.

#### How you can help at home...

- \*Read **every day** with your child and talk about the book to check your child's understanding.
- \*Give your child the opportunities to write about what they have done with you at the weekend.
- \*Help your child with their home learning, home learning is given on a Friday and should be handed in on Mondays. It is used to consolidate learning of that week or prepare your child for next week's learning.



## In Maths

The children will be learning to count to 100, addition and subtraction. We will also be starting new learning around multiplication and addition. Try counting in 2, 5 and 10 at home daily and completing TT Rockstars challenges for 5 minutes every day! (Please ask the teacher for a new log in and password if you cannot find yours).

### How you can help at home...

- \*Learn to count in 2's, 5's and 10's.
- \*Enjoy math's with your child, look for patterns and play number games, for example snakes and ladders.
- \*Help your child with their weekly math's homework.
