In English

The children will be looking at a different genre of writing every two weeks. We will also have a grammar focus each week that will be linked with their English learning. Every

Friday the children will complete a big write using all of the skills we have learned during the week. This term we will be looking at fiction writing relating to the Romans, as well as a number of nonfiction texts based in the rainforest.

*Read to your child EVERY DAY, make sure they hear different stories and enjoy favourite ones regularly so they can re-tell them on their own.

*Share your child's reading book with them EVERY DAY and talk about the different things happening in the pictures.

*Ask your children about their learning that day.

*Ask your child to talk through their week's learning and explain what they are writing about

In Maths

This half term there is a focus on place value and formal written methods, as well as mental methods. The whole year 4 target is to learn their multiplication tables up to 12x12, as well as their division facts. We will also be looking at time and mass (weight). We will be looking at decimals and their fraction equivalents.

How you can help at home.... *Let your child pay when you go to the shops to buy a few items. *When you are at home or walking around town or driving in the car get your recite their multiplication tables and division facts * Help the children to tell the time, digital and analogue. When setting times about going somewhere point out the different times on the clock. Also point out the different between the long hand and short hand.

*Help your child to recall their multiplication facts. These should be being practised daily using Times Table Rockstars.
