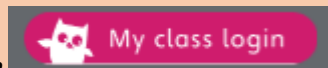
### **Reading:**

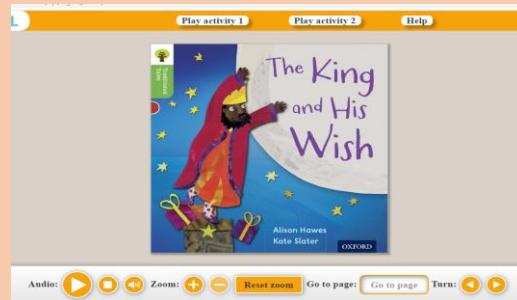
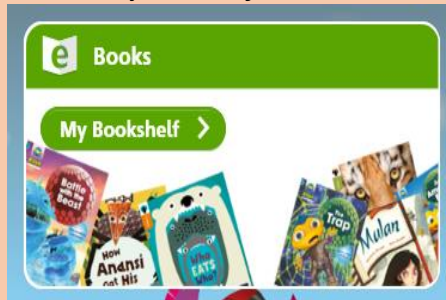

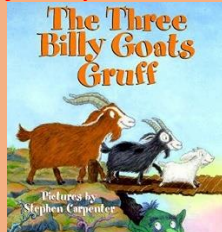
Click on 'My Bookshelf' to access the book.
