<b>English</b>		<b>Completed by...</b>
<b>Spelling/Phonics:</b>	<p><i>This week in phonics the children will be introduced to the sounds s/a/t/p We will be asking the children to look at objects beginning with the 4 letters and then match it to the correct letter. For example matching a sun to the letter 'S'. We are teaching the children to hear the initial sound in words, whilst you are cooking or out and about point out different objects beginning with s/a/t/p and ask them what the first sound is that they can hear such as for tin the initial sound is t. <b>Please remember we are teaching the letter sounds not the letter names.</b></i></p> <p><a href="https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zf2yf4j/articles/z4ycrj6">https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zf2yf4j/articles/z4ycrj6</a></p> <p>The link above has a video which demonstrates the correct way to pronounce the sound and will be useful for the children to watch.</p> <p>Please also complete the attached worksheet, ask the children to name the picture shown and then circle the initial sound for that picture.</p>	Monday 12 <sup>th</sup> October
<b>Reading:</b>	<p><i>Your child should now have an Oxford Reading Tree book in their book bag that we ask should be shared with them at least 3 times a week.</i></p> <p><i>We have noticed that the children are not secure with the Oxford Reading Tree characters that appear in each of the books. Please spend some time going over them and recalling their names, then when you read with your child you can ask them who the characters are. The characters are shared on an attached page.</i></p>	3 times per week.
<b>Writing:</b> 	<p><i>Please work with your child to write their name independently.</i></p> <p><i>Whilst your child is writing their name please encourage them to use the correct pencil grip and form their letters correctly.</i></p>	Every day


