Spelling/Phonics:	<p><i>This week in phonics the children will be introduced to the sounds i/n/m/d We will be asking the children to look at objects beginning with the 4 letters and then match it to the correct letter. For example matching a net to the letter 'N'. We are teaching the children to hear the initial sound in words, whilst you are cooking or out and about point out different objects beginning with i/n/m/d and ask them what the first sound is that they can hear such as for net the initial sound is n. Reading:	<p><i>Your child should now have an Oxford Reading Tree book in their book bag that we ask should be shared with them at least 3 times a week.</i></p> <p><i>We have noticed that the children are not secure with the Oxford Reading Tree characters that appear in each of the books. Please spend some time going over them and recalling their names, then when you read with your child you can ask them who the characters are.</i></p>	3 times per week.
Writing:	<p><i>Please work with your child to write their name independently.</i></p> <p><i>Whilst your child is writing their name please encourage them to use the correct pencil grip and form their letters correctly.</i></p>	Every day

Maths	<p><i>This half term in maths we have been looking at numbers to 10. After working with the children on recognising the numbers and ordering the numbers we then asked the children to collect an amount of objects. This week we would like the children to read the number by the circle box and cut out the correct number of sweets and add it to the circle box.</i></p>	Monday 26 th October







Phonics Worksheet 3 Circle the correct letter sound


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
