

Spelling/Phonics:




Practice your phonics sounds that your teacher has set you on purple mash.

Reading:

Remember to read your reading book with a family member at least **3 times throughout** the week. Try re-telling the story to check if your child has understood what has happened in the story and see if they can remember any characters.

After reading

- Start to retell the story in your own words and encourage your child to join in. Look back at the pictures together to support your child.
- Look at p5 again. Ask: *How do you think Pip felt after she let the balloon go?*
- Read p6 of the story again. Ask: *What does 'bobs' mean?* (Answer: moves gently up and down.) Ask: *Can you move your hand like a bobbing balloon?*
- Look at the picture on p10. Ask: *Why is the hen running?* (Answer: e.g. it is afraid of the balloon.)

Story words

Read the story words that were introduced in this book together, then ask your child to find them within the book. Ask them to tell you what each word means, prompting if necessary.

balloon (p3, 4, 6, 12) **dragon** (p4)

Writing:

Over the half term holidays we would love you to keep **practicing your writing every day!** Practice your handwriting, taking care with each letter. We would love for you to write us some super sentences over the holidays telling us what you have been up to. Remember to use your non-negotiables :


