Strategies to help you learn your spellings

Which way of learning spellings do you prefer? Here are some ideas for you to try. Can you think of any others?

Have a go! Which words did you spell correctly? Which words did you find more difficult? Look for the 'tricky' bits.	Look - Say - Cover - Write - Check
Trace/say - Copy/say - Repeat/say	Segment - split the word into its constituent phonemes. Clap and count - how many syllables does the word have?
