Spelling/Phonics:

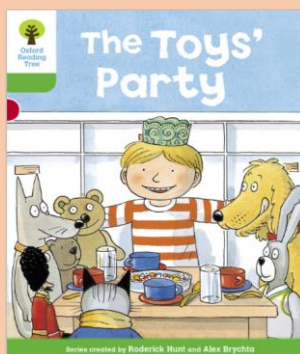

Reading:

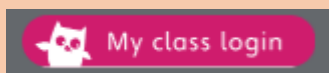
