Homemade Musical instruments

SHAKERS



You will need:

- An empty container (e.g. a yoghurt pot or a plastic drinks bottle)
- Container lid or tinfoil
- Tape
- Something to put inside the container to make a sound (e.g. dry pasta, rice, beans)

What to do:

- 1. Fill your clean and dry container with pasta/rice/beans
- 2. Screw the lid back on/Tape tinfoil onto your container
- 3. Decorate your container with paint, stickers etc. (optional)



Rainstick



You will need:

- A sturdy cardboard tube (from a kitchen paper towels roll/an aluminium foil roll/cling film roll etc.)
- A sheet of card/paper
- Tape
- Dry rice
- Paint (optional)
- Pipe cleaners/tinfoil (optional)

What to do:

- 1. Paint your cardboard tube and leave out to dry (optional)
- 2. Cut two large circles out of the card/paper
- 3. Attach one of the circles to the end of the cardboard tube using (a lot of) tape
- 4. Twist pipe cleaners/tinfoil into a spiral and place them inside your tube (optional)





- 5. Fill in your rainstick with rice
- 6. Tape the other circle to the open end of the tube
