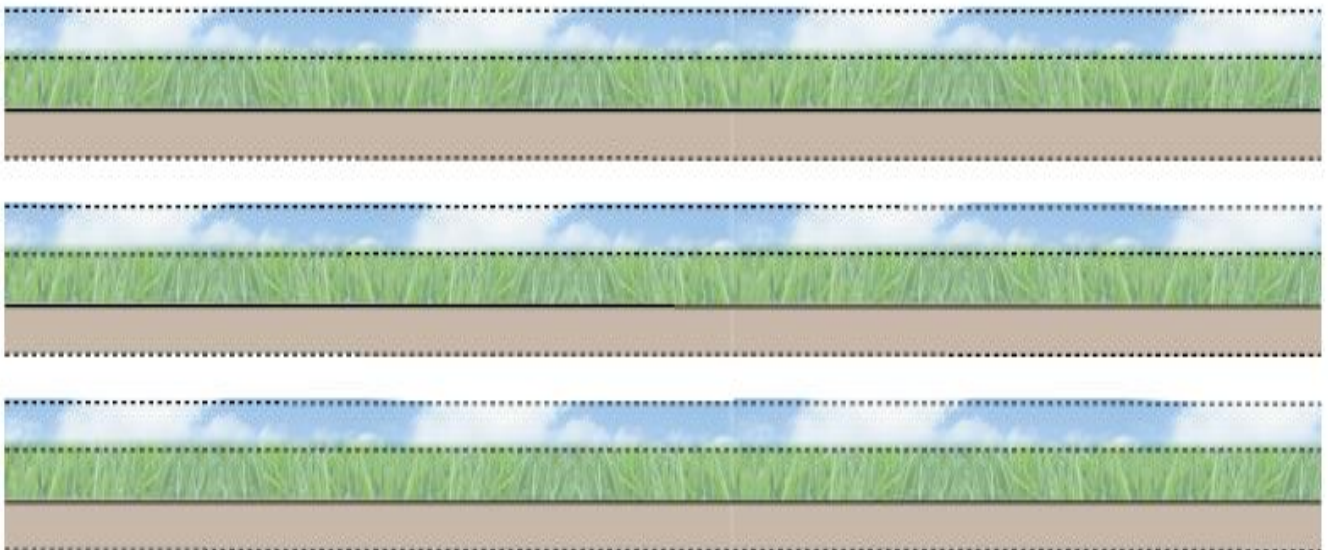


3D Shape
