



In class we use the sentence starter 'She is/ He is and He has/She has when describing a character and this is what we want the children to start their sentences with today. Remember just like with the example I have made the children write phonetically which means they write the sounds they can hear in words so it will not look like how we would write our words but this is correct for reception writing and what we expect to see. Some children might only hear the initial sound in words and others might only hear the initial and final sound. We can't wait to see what sentences the children come up with to describe Little Red and the Wolf.




For your English activity today you need to open the template on seesaw where you will 6 six pictures from the story and 6 words.


